**Parking and Conduct of Parents at North Borough Junior School**

Dear Parents and Carers

Both I and the Headteacher of St. Paul's Infant School were informed today by a local resident that they were appalled by the conduct of a parent who has children either at North Borough Junior School/St. Paul's Infant School/Or both schools. We were informed that at 3.30pm on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> November 2016 that the traffic was backed up and people were refusing to move or unable to manoeuvre. As a result, one woman (Parent) got out of her car, stormed down the road shouting abuse at a driver and tried to open the door of his car whilst shouting at him. She then walked back to her car, shouting expletives at other parents.

Whilst we understand that the traffic outside both schools has increased over the years, we are appalled by this behavior. If you witness behavior like this, please contact the police immediately.

Whilst we know that incidents like this are rare, we would urge you to be respectful to local residents by:

- a) Not parking in residential parking bays
- b) Not parking/drop off on the yellow zig zag lines for the safety of pupils, parents and the general public
- c) Being courteous to other road users and residents
- d) Refrain from using expletives
